

As such, I don't feel that I reserve any type of disciplinary actions as is being contemplated on me vide your Memo under reference. In case any disciplinary action is required to be taken on any body on this ground, the S.S.E. who is suppose to cordinate in the settlement works at Port Blair who misguided you to send the clothese to S/Island to fix me unnecessarily should be directed to explain for his gross negligency of duty.

Under the circumstances explained above I am to request you that the action levelled against me may kindly be dropped as I have no intension to disobey the orders of my superiors. I have returned the clothese with the real intension that the formalities and stitching are to be done at Port Blair, the clothese are returned and the entire things will be explained in person to do the things in a proper way.

Hope you would relieve me from the above allegations please.
