

BYE LAWS

THE ONGEES' MULTI-PURPOSE COOPERATIVE SOCIETY LTD.
HUT BAY, LITTLE ANDAMAN.

1. Name and Address :- The Society be called the Onges' Multi-purpose Cooperative Society Ltd., No. 225 Registered under the Co-operative Societies Act II of 1912.

Its registered address shall be at Hut Bay P.O., Hut Bay, Police Station- Hut Bay, Little Andaman in the district of Port Blair, A & N Islands.

2. Area of Operation :- The area of operation of the Society shall extend to the entire Little Andaman Islands.
3. Objects :- (a) To encourage Thrift and Self help among the members.

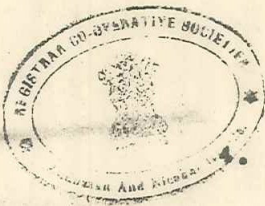
(b) To dispose of the produce and collection of the members including minor forest produce to the best advantages of the member.

(c) To undertake fisheries activities including shell fishing, cottage industries and other subsidias activities and arrange market for these products.

(d) To procure and supply the daily necessities of the members.

(e) To assist the members in leading a civil life and

(f) To do such other things which will be conducive to the growth and properties of the Onges



Membership :

(a) Any person above 18 years of age who is of the Onges Tribe and of sound mind is eligible to become a member of the Society.

(b) The State Cooperative Bank Ltd., Government Apex Cooperative Institution may be member in the event of participation in the Society's share.

(c) Those who have signed the original application for registration shall be among the members of the Society.

(d) Such other persons who are genuinely interested in the welfare of the Onges Tribe and are nominated as members by the Deputy Commissioner/Tribal Welfare Officer/representative. But the number should never exceed 1/3 of the total number of members belonging to the Onges Tribe at the time of registration. Those eligible for membership under Bye-Law No. 4(a) can apply for membership to the Managing Committee of the Society. The Committee, however, reserves the right to admit or reject the application for membership assigning reasons therefor. In case of rejection, an appeal may be made to the Registrar whose decision shall be final.

5. Each member shall have to pay an admission fee of Rs. 10/- and should hold at least one share before exercising right of membership.

6. Share Capital :- The authorised capital of the society shall be Rupees Fifty thousand made up of 4000 shares of the value of Rs. 10/- each for individual members and
