- (i) To take notice of any other matters which might affect the financial position of the Society and to adopt resolution with regard to them and
- (j) to transact any other business.
14. a) All resolutions placed before the Annual General Body or Special General Body meeting for consideration shall be decided by a majority votes subject to the directives given in the Act, rules and bye-laws. In case of equality of votes, the Chairman can exercise a second vote or a casting vote. But, the Chairman cannot exercise the casting vote in the case of an election. It must be decided by lots in case of a tie.
- b) All matters discussed or decided at the General Body Meeting shall be recorded in the minutes book and it shall be signed by the Chairman and the Secretary of the Society.

15. Managing Committee :-

The Managing Committee shall consist of Nine members of whom two shall be the nominees of the Registrar and two of the Deputy Commissioner and/or Tribal Welfare Officer and the five elected by the General Body. The Managing Committee so comprised shall elect from among themselves a Chairman, a Secretary and a Treasurer.

16. The elected members of the Managing Committee shall hold office continuously for two years. An elected member can be removed from office by 2/3 of the members present in the General Body Meeting and voting.

17. Outgoing members of the Managing Committee shall be eligible for re-election. But, no member shall continue as a member of the Managing Committee for more than three in succession without the special sanction of the Registrar.

18. The term of the Managing Committee shall be two years from the date of election/constitution of the Board of Management.

19. If any casual vacancy arises among the elected members of the Managing Committee, the members of the Managing Committee shall coopt any person from among the members of the Society to fill up the vacancy for the unexpired portion of the tenure of the Managing Committee and he shall be eligible to be elected as office bearer for that unexpired period.

20. (a) No members shall be eligible to be elected as a member of the Managing Committee, if he is :

- (i) below 18 years of age
(ii) adjudged as an insolvent
(iii) of unsound mind

- (b) If he has undergone imprisonment for criminal offence involving moral turpitude within five years, immediately preceding the date of his election.

- (c) If he is in default to the Society.

- (d) A member of the Managing Committee shall forfeit his office in the Managing Committee for the following reasons :

- (i) himself or his close relative accepts an appointment under the Society or receives any remuneration from the Society, other than honorarium prescribed by the Managing Committee.
