- pumpkin, drum sticks, banana etc may be planted / raised in Dugong Creek with active involvement of Onges
- f) The lactating and pregnant Onge mothers may be supplied iron rich vegetables and food supplements regularly on recommendation of Medical Personnel. A standing order may be issued so that every time the Tribal Welfare Officer need not wait for approval from AAJVS. But the factual position can be intimated to Executive Secretary, AAJVS
- g) Pregnant mother should be provided supplementary diet immediately on detection of the pregnancy
- h) Construction of a medical sub-centre building at Dugong Creek with all facilities.
- i) A separate visitors register / diary may be maintained by officials of each department at Dugong Creek. The touring officers / officials of the respective department may record their observation in the diary for taking necessary action. The department concerned having branch at Dugong Creek may be appraised and request them for compliance by their officers / officials on tour at Dugong Creek.
- j) In the monthly progress report of the Tribal Welfare Officer / In-Charge of AAJVS, the details of visiting officers / officials may be included.
- k) Departments like Social Welfare, Agriculture and Veterinary may be appraised with the problems prevailing with Onges in particular and Dugong Creek in general and request them to depute men / materials to address the problem;
- A grievance redressal mechanism may be evolved so that the Officers / officials of line departments regularly visit Dugong Creek and address the situation. Logistics support may be started by AAJVS as has been approved by the competent authority
- m) The Tribal Welfare Officer / In-charge of Onges Settlement supplies free ration to the Onges, ration articles for mid day meals and Anganwadi centre. A check to verify regularity and prevention of exploitation needs to be taken.
- n) The population of dogs needs to be controlled.
- o) The sub-committee may meet once in every three month to review the implementation of supply of free ration and other issues raised. The defects / problems may be reviewed / addressed during the review meeting.
