The above Society is unable to make payment to CCS Ltd, Supply department and other firms at Little Andaman as it had not received payment for the above months from AAJVS.

The above excess supply of ration articles were made during the period of Dr. Bisweswar Das, Social Worker, Dugong Creek between November 2005 to July 2006. Now since these ration articles have been distributed to the Onges, AAJVS has to bear the expenditure and make payment to Onges Multipurpose Co-operative Society Ltd. Dugong Creek. Subject to sanction of expenditure, AAJVS will sustain a loss of Rs.30,952.37 as detailed at para 33/N, on account of excess supply of free ration to the Onges over and above the prescribed scale of distribution un-authorizedly.
