In response to your memorandum No. 594 dt. 16/1/07 I am to say that the charges levelled against me is not fact, so I am submitting the information/facts for your kind consideration Plz.

That Sir, I was distributed the items as per the previous records/reference available at our camp near the forest of Verekananda Pur. & A after Tsunami.

After Tsunami the physical condition of Ongees of Dugong Creek and South Bay was very bad, they were kept at RK. Pur School ground and at Ongee Tikri, & Bay respectively and subsequently shifted to their own made hut interior in the forest, V.R Pur area, The Captain of the Ongees and Shri Tambalai and Badaraj, Ugalai approach to the Tehsildar & Commissioner (R.R). for ration item etc. As the Ongees are fully depend upon the ration, Hunting, fishing was not in practice due to the terror of Tsunami. Tehsildar & Commissioner (CRR) verbally directed to issue the ration items to the Ongees as per their need on demand. Due to frequent shifting of Ongees Camp they are wasting the ration & other items, and in each new camp they demand for fresh rations & other item, Matter was also discussed with the officers of T.H. during their visit during that period.

I have not violated the prescribed scale and any other relevant rules belongs to our department & Ongees. All the information, records and register of above said issue related with the memo. is available with D/c. office, The Ongees were finally shifted to their old settlement, i.e. D/creek. Some time may-06.
