- 1) On basis of the number of Minor and Adult members of Onge families as Dr. B. Das mentioned in the Ration Distribution Chart for the months of Nov 05, Jan-Apr 2006 and Jun-Jul 2006 and the prescribed scale of free ration (As per Office Order No 361 dated 28-10-1998), and the contemporary value of items, the OMPCS' ration bills submitted by Dr. B. Das submitted for the above said months scrutinized and fresh bills No 2337-2347 dated 6-2-2007 reproduced and attached here with. The detail of which given above and below.
 - 2) On scrutiny of the bills for the months of Nov 05, Jan-Apr 2006 and Jun-Jul 2006 submitted by Dr. B. Das it is found that the quantity of ration items issued to Onges is not tallied correctly with the prescribes scale of ration as per Order No 361 dated 28-10-1998 from Office of the Executive Secretary, AAJVS. Excess quantity of some ration items issued to Onges amounting to Rs. 44060.19 and ration items worth Rs 23332.53 were not issued to Onges during the said months in accordance with the prescribed ration scale.
 - 3) Whereas Dr. B. Das has supplied excess quantity of ration to Onges and the same deducted in the fresh bills being submitted by self and whereas the items not supplied to Onges reflecting the less quantity of ration items given as per the prescribed scale to Onges are placed in the same manner in the fresh bills; because we can not give any after effect to or make any kind of change in the original distribution chart submitted by Dr. Das.
 - 4) While preparing the fresh bills the contemporary value of items taken into account from the old bills submitted by Dr. Das for the respective months.
