The normal helicopter fare from Port Blair to Hut Bay is R.213/- per head. In the instant case two persons are insisting to give go to Dugong Creek by helicopter. Since Dugong Creek is not a scheduled station there seems to be a claim for diversion of the helicopter to Dugong Creek, the amount of which is not known to this office. However, to divert the helicopter to Dugong Creek, sanction of the Hon'ble Lt. Governor is necessary.
