Professor, Ishwar C. Verma and four Research Officers from the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi and two Scientists from Hyderabad are reaching in Port Blair by IAC Flight on the 3rd. December, 1988 to carry out Health study of the Andamanese of Strait Island and the Onges of Little Andaman.

The team intends stay in this territory for 5 to 6 weeks in all. The team will spend one week in Strait Island and the rest of the time will be spent in South Bay and Dugong Creek respectively. Professor I.C. Verma will, however, return to Delhi after two weeks leaving the team behind to continue their studies.

Details of the programme and requisition for m.v. Milale etc. will be played after consulting Prof. I.C. Verma shortly.
