With reference to the your letter No.IV-8/AAJAS/87-TW dated 11.4.1988 regarding Smti. Lechoo, Andamanee Tribe who was admitted in the TB Ward for tuberculosis treatment, I am to inform you that she has been discharged on 11th April, 1988, with the direction to report back for collection of drug and follow up within one month. She has also been given Anti Tuberculosis Drugs equivalent to 45 days consumption at the time of her discharge. After the first follow up, Medicines for 4 months consumption may be issued to the compounder in-charge, Strait Island dispensary, who can distribute the drug to her under his personal care and supervision.


You are requested to ensure her regular consumption of Anti Tuberculosis Drugs for 6 more months, without any interruptions as any interruption in the in-take of drug ^{well} worsen her condition. This is for your information.
