I would like to refer to the discussions Dr. Subbakrishna, Anthropological Survey of India, had with you during his recent visit to Mysore last month, regarding a boy who belongs to Onge tribe in this territory.

Dr. Subbakrishna informed us that he had discussed with you about the boy and you had very kindly assured that you would do everything possible to make the boy gain his facilities. The letter received from Dr. Subbakrishna is enclosed for reference. I am extremely grateful for your kind offer and would like to send the boy to Mysore.

The boy, although suffers from hearing and speaking disability appears to be very smart and intelligent. His father and mother died few years back and is being looked after by other elders in the community. Along with the boy, his guardian will be accompanying him to Mysore. As these people are confined to their settlement in forests, their movement to the city direct from jungle might cause inconvenience to them and as such it would be necessary to provide some special arrangement for their stay there.
