The boy, although suffers from hearing and speaking disability appears to be very smart and intelligent. His father and mother died few year back and is being looked after by other elders the community. Alongwith the boy, his guardin be accompanying him to Mysore. As these people confined to their settlement in forests, the movement to the city direct from jungle might considered inconvenience to them and as such it would be start to provide some special arrangement for their stay there.
