Sub:- Referral of two Andamanese Children to Madras.

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Sir,

Babies Tong, 8 years and Kaaba alias Amrita, 6 Years daughter of Shri Pojeh of Strait Island, have been under treatment for Anaemia with hepato-splena megaly for the last few years. The treatment included frequent blood transfusions, sometimes two to three times in a year too.

It is, therefore, decided to refer the two children alongwith the Attending Physician, Dr. B.Shannughan, C.M.O. to Madras to interact with the Haematologist, Egmore hospital for follow up action etc.

I am, therefore, to request you to arrange an Airlift, preferably on the 28th or 29th July, 88, to the following:

1. Two Children (Patients)
2. Parents (One each for a patient)
3. Attending Physician
4. Responsible person (One) from the AAJVS to takecase of non-medical affairs like Board and Lodging, Transport etc.

The investigations and consultation with Haematologist is essential at the earliest. *for diagnosis and treatment.*
