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vis-a-vis the change in climate, it would not be in a position to give proper recommendation beneficial to Jarwas Community. The committee has prayed ^{for} 12 months time to file their report giving necessary suggestions for improving the quality of life of Jarwas Community from 10th September, 2001. We feel that this is a reasonable request ^{and for making} and a proper study, according to us, would require as much time.

In that view of the matter, we extended ^{time} to file report in terms of the court's order dated 9th April, 2001 by 12 months from 10th of September, 2001. We hope and expect that the committee would devise the scheme to better the life of Jarwas Community keeping and maintaining their own tradition.

The Committee so constituted by the Government is requested to file an interim report before the Circuit Bench to be held in the month of April, 2002 indicating thereby as to what progress the Committee has ^{made} in terms of the order of this court dated 9th April, 2001 until 31st March, 2002.

Mr. Saroop, Learned Government Pleader has submitted that he would serve copies of affidavits filed before us today to Shri Roy, Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of the intervenor as well as to the petitioner.
