

- (x) The draft report on the Jarawas on the basis of the survey / study in the first phase will be placed before the Expert Committee scheduled to meet on 18.3.2002, for a further discussion and decision on finalization of the interim report and the nature and type of interim report to be submitted to the Hon'ble High Court.
- (xi) Director General, ICMR, New Delhi may be replied to requesting for a study as quickly as possible so that the findings and recommendations of such team could also be examined by the Expert Committee, if possible before the Committee submits its report to the Hon'ble High Court.
- (xii) The DHS in consultation with Prof. Indira Chakraborty of AIIPH&H will identify any specific issues or aspects which need to be studied by ICMR group so as to enable the Admn to take up the matter with ICMR before **15.3.2002**.
- (xiii) The Expert Medical team as constituted by Director General, Indian Council of Medical Research, New Delhi may also be requested to study and find out as to whether various norms / indices including balanced diet worked out for the general population are applicable to the community like Jarawa *ipso facto* or needs alteration
- (xiv) Dr. (Mrs) Namita Ali, Director of Health Services and Professor Indira Chakravorthy shall include the matter of specification of the norms / indices while framing the issues / aspects to be studied by the Expert Medical team constituted by Director General ICMR.
- (xv) The Members of the Composite Groups who have not submitted their weekly progress report for the study conducted during the first phase of the survey shall send the same to the Director of Tribal Welfare immediately.
- (xvi) In response to large number of letters received from various countries, the relevant details shall be placed in the website of A & N Administration. The reply shall include all relevant details in brief and will be approved by the Expert Committee before the reply is put in the website.
- (xvii) The usual logistical support for the Composite Groups will be provided by AAJVS during the subsequent phases of survey among the Jarawas.
- (xviii) The second phase of the survey among the Jarawas will commence from 10th April 2002. All concerned departments and authorities
