PUC is a letter at page 129 /C, preferred by the Deputy Director (Tribal Health), A&N Administration, Port Blair. A request has been made for arrangements for the transit of two resource persons of the All India Institute of Hygiene and Public Health, Calcutta, to impart Health and Nutritional training in detail to the composite team members from 6.8.2002.

Here it is to mention that two phases of Jarawa study had already been undertaken and the 3rd and final phase is to commence from 10th of August 2002. An interactive meeting was held on 17.7.2002 at Marine Hill Circuit House in presence of Shri K.B. Saxena, member, Expert Committee on Jarawa constituted by Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, wherein Prof. Indira Chakravarty had stated that 2 technical staff would be deputed from AIIH&PH to impart the training.

It was decided in the Expert Committee meeting held on 6.11.2001 that the expenditure incurred on the Jarawa study would be borne by AAJVS.

Hence it is proposed that we may procure tickets from ANIIDCO ltd. and send the same to AIIH&PH by speed post on confirmation of the name of the two staff.
