

Experts by going inside the Jarawa territory, after themselves being properly inoculated, and by establishing contact with the Jarawas for ascertaining their views, if possible.

- 3. The said Committee shall submit its report within six months from the formation of such Committee before the Central Government and the Lieutenant Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and also shall file a copy thereof before the Circuit Bench of this Court.
- 4. Your humble petitioner states that the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta have constituted the Committee of Experts vide their Notification No.14040/24/99/ANL dated 21st July,2001.
