2. The Committee shall undertake the aforesaid research, scientific study and survey in the manner as deemed fit by it. The Members of the Committee may visit the Jarawa territory after getting themselves properly inoculated for establishing contact with them for ascertaining their views, if possible, for the aforesaid purpose.

3. The Committee shall submit its report to the Central Government and the Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and also shall file a copy thereof before the Circuit Bench (Port Blair) of the High Court of Calcutta within six months from the date of its constitution.

4. The Committee shall clearly spell out in its report the reasons which, according to it, have caused such change in the behaviour of Jarawas and suggest remedial measures to enable the Central Government and the A&N Administration to formulate plans and programmes to save the Jarawas from the danger of total extinction or of losing their identity and culture by merger with the vast humanity of the so-called civilized society.

5. For the purpose of TA/DA, the non-official member(s) of the Committee will be treated as equivalent to Grade I Officers of the Central Government entitled to travel by air.
