

- g) To prevent contacts with the Jarawas by unauthorized persons.
 h) To take penal measures against the encroachers, poachers and who destroy the forest and also against the police and civil administrative authorities who are negligent in taking steps against the poachers, encroachers and destructor of forest.

The concerned departments have been requested to implement the above short term measures and submit the monthly report to this Administration.

Further, in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court to form a high powered committee, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A & N Islands has been pleased to constitute a high powered committee, consisting of the following officers, to monitor all the above short term measures and also to ensure that such steps are taken with all seriousness and with utmost expedition.

The committee shall meet periodically to review the implementation of the above short term measures. It shall interact with the Jarawa people of the nearby villages by holding regular meetings and it is to give fruits, clothing and gifts to them. The Committee is doing so and to teach them their basic rights and introduce them to the system.

To give proper instructions to submit a monthly report for the Secretary (TW) every month. The report will be submitted to him by keeping him in a secret session.
