As usual I today visited the Onge and Jarawa patients undergoing Medical treatment in G.B Pant Hospital, Port Blair and enquired of their health conditions. The Onge patient namely- Mrs. Neelai is recovering while the two Jarawa patients namely- Momo and Anate have been cured and they will be discharged from the hospital tomorrow. Necessary arrangements are being made to drop back the Jarawas to their habitat immediately after they are discharged.

The Nursing Sister-in-charge stated that the Jarawa/Onge ward is frequently required to be cleaned as the Jarawas are not as conscious of cleanliness as are expected, but they are not getting sufficient sanitary items from the Medical Department. Therefore the supply of sanitary items is to be supplemented by AAJVS out of its own fund during the period the tribals are admitted for treatment. She has asked for 2 kgs of bleaching powder and one bottle phenyl to be supplied by AAJVS.
