In this connection, to look after Jarawa boys, a group 'D' employee Shri Appa Rao has been deployed. It is sorry to inform you that this concerned group 'D' employee reported for the duty at 9.00 AM and he is not aware about whether any food has been given to Jarawa boys particularly the boy suffering from Tuberculosis. On my asking, he has not enquired whether the Jarawa boys have taken anything in the morning before reporting of his duty at 9.00 AM who supposed to report the duty at 8.00 AM as per the official order. It is, therefore, suggested to take explanation from Shri Appa Rao for not doing his duty sincerely and punctually. And it is also once again reiterated that have a close watch on the employees who have been deployed for dealing with Jarawas.
