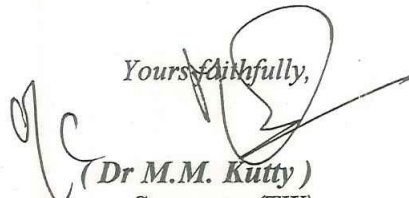
Sub: Combined use of vehicle provided for welfare of the Jarawas – reg:

Sir,

I am directed to say that a Medical Officer has been appointed under AAJVS and stationed at Primary Health Centre, Tirur for providing medical aids to the Jarawas. As per the terms of appointment he is required to visit Jarawa camps on ATR including Middle Strait three days viz; Monday, Wednesday & Friday a week and the remaining days he is to remain attached to Primary Health Centre, Tusnabad and also to provide medical coverage to the Jarawas of Tirur area, but it has been reported that he is not able to carry out the task for want of transport. In this context it may be mentioned that a jeep has been hired by AAJVS and stationed at JPP Tirur for administering welfare measures for the Jarawas. In fact the jeep is to be used by JPP as well as staffs of AAJVS for welfare of Jarawas.

It is therefore requested that the above jeep may also be made available to the Medical Officer and Pharmacist attached to Primary Health Centre, Tushnabad on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays for visiting Jarawa camps on ATR and also for providing medical aids to the Jarawas of Tirur area as and when required.
