May please see the notes from para 80/N onwards. It is regarding providing of transport to Medical Officer stationed at Primary Health Centre Tushnabad for providing medical coverage to the Jarawas on ATR as well as the Jarawas of Tirur area. The Medical Officer has stated that he is not able to carry the task for want of transport. In this connection it is stated that a jeep has been hired and stationed at JPP Tirur by AAJVS. We may therefore request the IGP to spare the above jeep for medical coverage of the Jarawas, if approved. A draft letter to IGP is placed below for approval please.

It has been reported by medical officer Dr. B.H. Yogesh that, the jeep stationed at JPP Tirur is being used by a Police Inspector Mr. Bedam who refusing to share the vehicle with the medical officer, hence the doctor is facing the problem in evaluation of sick patients to PHC Tushnabad. Further, the doctor said that if he is alone going to middle-strait, he then he is travelling by bus, but, he badly required the jeep for the evacuation of sick patients found at R.K. Wallah and middle-strait. Further the jeep is not required at tirur for all the hours as the jarawas of this area scattered in the thick forest, hence the jeep has to go to middle-strait by using the ATR for patrolling. It is therefore the authorities of Police may be requested for sparing the jeep for Monday, Wednesday and Friday for doctor and also at the same time the patrolling duty may be performed. If approved a draft letter to IGP is placed for approval. please
