It is submitted that the 3 Jarawa patients who were admitted in G.B Pant Hospital for treatment has been run away by to-day morning i.e. 20th June 01 by bus to their area without the knowledge of medical staff or the staff posted by us. It is understood that those Jarawas left for their area by bus. We have engaged three daily rated employees at G.B.Pant Hospital to look after the Jarawas round the clock. But it is presumed that they could not attended their duty properly.

We can spare two of them for out door duty. S/Shri T.Appa Rao and Ram Nath Singh can depute to G.B.Pant Hospital to attend the duty for the tribal patients as and when they are in medical treatment. We can entrust the work as under:

1. Shri Ram Nath Singh - from 0700 hrs to 1500 hrs
2. Shri T. Appa Rao - from 2200 hrs to 0700 hrs
