Please refer para 50/N. Suggestions are made hereon with the reference to the letter No. 07 dated 27th Aigust, 2001 received from Dy. Director (Tribal Health), A&N Administration, Port Blair are as follows:-

- 1. A Pharmacist may be deputed to their habitat (Jarawa) fortnightly basis from Middle Strait to provide treatment to the present Jarawa.
- 2. Medical aid may be given to the Jarawa at their habitat to prevent the mixing of Jarawa with General population.
- 3. A Pharmacist may be visited Potatang on daily basis to attend the visiting Jarawa folk.
- 4. A temporary camp of a Pharmacist with subordinate staff can be provided at Spike Island to attend the Jarawa near to their habitat. So that we may avoid to admit many Jarawas to PHC, Kadamtala / Tushnabad and G.B. Pant, Port Blair who do not have any major illness.
- 5. Separate specialist doctors team may be deputed quarterly to Jarawa area to investigate the general health of the Jarawa as a whole.
