Please refer para 50/N. Suggestions are made hereon with the reference to the letter No. 07 dated 27th August, 2001 received from Dy. Director (Tribal Health), A&N Administration, Port Blair are as follows:-

1. A Pharmacist may be deputed to their habitat (Jarawa) fortnightly basis from Middle Strait to provide treatment to the present Jarawa.
2. Medical aid may be given to the Jarawa at their habitat to prevent the mixing of Jarawa with General population.
3. A Pharmacist may be visited Potatang on daily basis to attend the visiting Jarawa folk.
4. A temporary camp of a Pharmacist with subordinate staff can be provided at Spike Island to attend the Jarawa near to their habitat. So that we may avoid to admit many Jarawas to PHC, Kadamtala / Tushnabad and G.B. Pant, Port Blair who do not have any major illness.
5. Separate specialist doctors team may be deputed quarterly to Jarawa area to investigate the general health of the Jarawa as a whole.
