May please see the Office notes at para 56-59/N above, A Jarawa who was admitted to G.B. Pant Hospital for treatment, is reported to have been discharged. So he is to be dropped back to his habitat. It is informally learnt that he belongs to Kadamtala area. Therefore he may be sent back to Kadamtala by a vehicle tomorrow accompanied by an escort to handover the Jarawas to the Tribal Welfare Officer, Kadamtala. There are 2 jeeps of AAJVS, but both are out of order. However action has been initiated to get the commander jeep repaired. In that case the Maruti Gypsy AN-01-A-8263 of the Tribal Welfare Department may be used for dropping the Jarawa to Kadamtala. Shri Jolly George, may be directed to accompany the Jarawa. He shall also disburse the salary of the staffs posted in the Jarawa area during his tour.
