Due to road traffic accident and injury on his right arm, the medical officer, Kadamtala has referred the case to GB Pant Hospital, Port Blair on 02.02.2001 and reached Port Blair on the same day evening. He is now under treatment. Made all arrangement to provide proper care to the boy at hospital. The Jarawa boy is alone. As attendant we required minimum 2 male hand at Hospital in addition to the new hand appointed on daily rated basis w.e.f 01.02.2001 to provide round the clock duty as attendant. The daily rated employees those who were employed earlier are not attended their duty, which were assigned them earlier. However, we required those hands to attend the duty as attendant for the patient as they know Jarawa language. It is proposed that we may engage two hands in addition the new hand appointed on daily rated basis on 01.02.2001.</p>
