Further I collected a statement prepared by I/C JPP Tirur about supply of gift items to Jarawas from April to June till date (copy enclosed), I also collected deployment chart of JPP Staff on 04/06/05 in the Tirur Area as well as, OP Tirur in order to know the presence of police personnel on 04/06/05 in Collinpur bazaar (copy enclosed).

From the perusal of statements of above mentioned persons as well as record collected pertaining to deployment of staff of AAJVS & JPP as well as food items provided to jarawas by AAJVS, it has come to notice that from May onwards. No any food item has been provided to jarawas by AAJVS staff & Jarawa were let off to survive on their own natural resources but on the other hand, jarawas have not followed principle of AAJVS & more inclined to come to settlement area for demanding food items due to their hungry. From every begin jarawas used to take bananas, coconut etc., from the plantation of settlers but after total discard for supply of food items to jarawas by AAJVS, jarawas have been started coming to settlement area of villages as well as collinpur market. It is also established that subsequently jarawas used to exchange their crabs, honey, dhoop from biscuit, pan, rice etc., (highly cheaper values) from villagers without any mind of its values where as villagers are getting crabs, honey, dhoop etc., in most cheap rate. So they were exciting to take jarawas items while coming towards settlement area. This was happened due to non- supply of food item to jarawas by AAJVS. It is also seen that they were uttering ward bhokh before people and showing their empty bellies. All this happened only when JPP staff and AAJVS staff were not present.

It is also fact that due to Tsunami effect at JPP Tirur No 4, the JPP staff has been withdrawn & shifted to JPP Tirur head quarter due to which patrolling in JPP Tirur No 4 area could not be maintained and jarawas used to come collinpur area, only one AAJVS staff is deputed for field duty who can not watch on the movement of jarawas in Tirur area. Two staff of AAJVS are engaged for medical care to jarawas. So publication made by Andaman Aaj Tak appears to be correct.
