

Suggestive Measures taken / to be taken.

1. Due to Tsunami effect on 26/12/04, infra-structure of JPP Tirur No. 4 was washed away and JPP staff was withdrawn and shifted to JPP Headquarter at Tirur by which patrolling in the Tirur & Collinpur was disrupted. Now, a suitable land has been selected near collinpur for re-establishing of JPP Tirur No 4 which will certainly monitor the movements of jarawas coming towards settlement area and vice-versa.

Round the clock day patrolling has been introduced in collingur bazaar and settlement area for checking over activities of settlers and

jarawas to avoid exchange of food items and interface.

3. Director Tribal Welfare may be asked to review case of non-supply of food items to jarawas against previous precedence. Otherwise adequate staff of AAJVS may be posted in the Tirur area to educate jarawas against their entering in tribal reserve area and demanding food from settlers. Simultaneously jarawa may also be advised to utilize their natural resources for their survival. It is pertinent to mention here that jarawas may only be handled tactfully and politely to maintain friendly atmosphere against their demands.

 Jarawas are being provided cooked food in Hospital and they are accustomed with the test of our food and they are liking leaving their

traditional food.

5. A police officer to the rank of SI may be posted at Tirur Headquarter for effective supervision and control.
