This receipt is from the Inspector General of Police regarding Jarawa interaction with non-tribals in South Andaman and also the publication appeared in the local news paper named "Aaj Tak" dated 15.06.05. The editor published in the news paper that "Ja4rawas were seen selling crabs in Collinpur Bazar in lieu of supply of biscuits by villages". The Dy. Superintendent of Police, Middle Andaman along with a team of 14 persons including public, shop keepers, staff of AAJVS, Staff of Jarawa Protection Post etc has been Enquirer to find out the facts of publication and furnished a detailed report to I.P.P. The enclosures is the sample copy of the report furnished by him to I.G.P.

In his report he has stated that from May onwards no any food item has been provided to Jarawas by AAJVS. and Jarawas were let off to survive on their own natural resources but on other hand, jarawas have not followed principle to AAJVS and more inclined to come to settlement area for demanding food items due to their hungry. From the begin jarawas used to take bananas, coconut etc. from plantation of settlers but after discard for supply of food items to Jarawas by AAJVS, Jarawas have been started coming to settlement area of villages as well as collinpur market. It is also established that subsequently jarawas used to exchange their crabs, honey, dhoop from biscuit, pan, rice etc. from villagers without any mind of its values. All this happened only when Jarawa Protection Post staff and AAJVS staff were not present.

It is also stated that due to Tsunami effect at Jarawa Protection Post Tirur No.4, the Jarawa Protection Post staff has been withdrawn & shifted to Jarawa Protection Post Tirur head quarter due to which patrolling in Jarawa Protection Post Tirur No.4 area could not be maintained and jarawas used to come collinpur area.

On the light of the above fact, the Dy.S.P. stated that the publication made by Andaman Aaj Tak appears to be correct.
