Sir,

I am enclosing herewith a list indicating No. of Jarawas noticed in various places as well as the food supplied to them by AAJVS. On perusal, it has been found that during the month of February, 2001 a total of 606 Nos of Jarawas were found on ATR and 675 kgs of Banana and 150 Nos of Coconuts were supplied to them. The quantity of food supplied by AAJVS is insufficient as a result these jarawas are used to sit on road side of ATR for snatching of food item from ATR user.

The No. of jarawas found at Kadamtala are supplied with sufficient food as a result the incident of looting by jarawas is not reported in the jurisdiction of P.S. Kadamtala.

The staff of AAJVS are not available full time on ATR with Police picketing party. The authority may be instructed to place their staff, On ATR till the closure of vehicle^{for} movement on ATR.

Anthropological Survey of India is not providing any of his staff at Tirur, Jirkatang and Kadamtala.

The food supplied to the jarawas in Tirur area is also insufficient as a result jarawas entered in Tirur village on 10/2/2001 to 11/2/2001 and forcibly taken away approx. 60 kgs of Banana from the garden of villages.
