I am to draw your immediate attention on the following facts that one Shri. Thatha Red, employee of Deptt. of Electricity is working as operator in the Power house since last couple of four years. He has been greatly disliked by the tribal members because of his some illicit activities and misbehavior with the tribes. As many of the tribal members reported, he exports rice, sugar, coconut, etc. to the outer islands as and when he gets opportunity. He offers higher also to the tribal youths to gain material benefits.

From the overall assessment through self interrogations and observation it is found that the said person has become very notorious among the tribes. The King of the G/ Andamanese community accompanied by other members urged that he should be replaced immediately with a new staff from the concerned deptt.


