P.U.C (1) is the letter No.282-3/2001-02-Pal/7123 dated 27.5.2002 from Dr.T.K.Paul, Scientists - E, Joint Director, Zoological Survey of India addressed to AAJVS regarding the difficulties expressed by him in preparing the report of the second phase survey in Jarawa area on account of non receipt of the specimens, they collected during the study of the Jarawas in the second phase. Permission was sought from Wildlife Division, A&N Administration to transport the specimen from the Jarawa areas for further scientific analysis. The Wildlife Division has not yet permitted them for the transportation.

P.U.C (2) is the letter No.CWLW/WL/26/504 dated 30th May 2002 from Chief Wildlife Warden, A&N Administration addressed to Executive Secretary, AAJVS regarding the permission sought by this office for transportation of the Zoological specimens collected from the Jarawa area by the team of Zoologist of Zoological Survey of India.

Wildlife Warden has intimated that required details like name of the species, the quantity of the species collected etc have not been intimated to them for consideration of the permission to transport the Zoological Survey of India for further scientific analysis. The Chief WildLife Warden has further asked copy of the order of the High Court in connection with the study of the Jarawas.

In this context we may write to the Dr.T.K.Paul, Scientist - E, Joint Director, Zoological Survey of India, Port Blair and also to Officer-in-Charge, Zoological Survey of India, Port Blair to furnish the required details to Chief Wildlife Warden immediately so that the Zoological Survey of India would get the specimens and enable them thereafter to prepare the report quickly.

Draft letter is placed opposite for perusal and approval.
