The amount has been spent on education, uniform , private tuition, medical treatment, accommodation, food and all other related matter for 12 No of Great Andamanese student, who are studying and staying in the school.</p>
(539)	<p>In this regard it is mention here that 12 Nos Great Andamanese are studying in different class (KG-2 to 10th) in VKV, Port Blair. Nine (09) students are staying in VKV Hostel and other three (03) are staying with their parents at Port Blair. List of student may please be seen at Flag – A.</p>
(540)	<p>For providing good and quality education for their bright future seven (07) students are provided private tuition as was decided during the meeting held in the Chamber of Secretary (TW) on 24.06.2009 that they shall be taught be separate tutors for 2-3 hours a day especially English, Hindi, Maths and the school shall submit the bill for each academic year to this office for necessary payment.
