This is regarding a letter (page 105/C) received from Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram, Port Blair stating that six Great Andamanese students were selected in a talent scout competition held on 13th and 14th November 2010 to represent A&N islands at the All India national tribal Archery Competition to be held at Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh under the aegis of Archery Association of India.

They have requested to grant permission for their travel to Vijayawada and depute Shri. Chotelal Kushwaha (warden) to accompany them. Request has also been made for eligible facilities for their participation in the competition like travel, daily allowance etc. The team is to leave by any sailing after 20th December 2010.

In this context, we have received a letter from the Secretary Vivekananda Kendra, Port Blair requesting to inform them about the decision of AAJVS on sending the Great Andamanese students to take part in the competition, the NOC from respective parent, expenditure involved their in, the escort official etc. The letter adds that the Kendra is unable to depute Shri. Chotelal Kushwaha warden as Official as he has to take care of children who are in the hostel.
