Sir,

I am directed to inform that Kumari Sardha Devi, ANM student selected from the tribal community of Strait Island has been absenting from training w.e.f 17.10.2011 to till date.

It is to communicate that the Final Examination of First year ANM course will be held w.e.f 14.11.2011. The Eligibility criteria for Admission to Examination are-

- 1. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each subject for appearing for examination.
- 2. A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before the award of Completion certificate.
- 3. The Student should complete all required practical experience, and record signed by the tutor and counter signed by Principal.

Kumari Saradha Devi has not completed her practical record, and has only 69% attendance against 259 working days. She has absented for about 80 days till date.

Therefore as per the criteria laid down in the syllabus and Regulations for Auxiliary Nurse and Midwives by Indian Nursing Council Kumari Sardha Devi is not eligible for admission to Final examination which is scheulded to be held from 14.11.2011. However she will be permitted to appear in the supplementary examination which will be held in May, 2012...
