These two receipts regarding the representation submitted to the Lt. Governor by Shri Sebastin S/o Vijakulam, R/o C/Bay.

It is seen from the notes at para 78-90 on page 27/N, file No.AAJVS/22/81-TW/1, that the appointment of S/Shri Sita Ram, a Nicobare and Dinesh Kumar, Shompen youth as Trekking Assistant at Great Nicobar, has been approved by the Lt. Governor subject to ratification by the Executive Council in its next meeting.

Subsequently the appointment of Shri V. Sebastin was taken up and recommended by the Director(TW) considering the necessity felt by the Assistant Commissioner, C/Bay, for a Taking Assistant in addition to the existing two. (para 82-84 page 28/N) This proposal was not agreed to by the Lt.

Governor who felt that two Trekees should be sufficient to help the present team of a Doctor and a Social Worker(Para 86 page 28 -N) Links Side.

Later one of these two persons who were appointed as Trekking Assistants i.e. the Shompen youth left the job causing a vacancy of Trekking Assistant at Campbell Bay.

Again the application of Shri Sebastian for appointment as

Trekking Assistant was examined vide page 34-46/N of linked

file No.AAJVS/22/81-TW/l and finally it was decided to trans
fer Shri T. Mohan, Gardner-cum-Mazdoor at Dugong Creek to

Campbell Bay. In response to the letter dated 3rd March, 84

regarding the appointment of Shri Sebastian we have informed

the Member of Parliament that there was no vacancy of Trekking

Assistant and the case of Shri Sebastian would be considered

at the appropriate time.

Later in the month of August, 1985 the services of Shri

T. Mohan were terminated vide order No. 210 dated 1st Aug:85.

The post of one Trekking Assistant is lying vacant.
