Sub:- Providing employment to Shri Gullet- regarding.

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Sir,

I am to inform you that Smti Leechu, 28 years, Andamanian woman, is a known case of Pulmonary tuberculosis. She has been undergoing domiciliary treatment for the last few months. But due to the irregularity in treatment, she had to be evacuated to Long Island and to Port Blair on two to three occasions in the past for severe chest pain and blood vomiting. The T.B. Officer, G.B. Pant Hospital, Port Blair has strongly recommended an intensive care and indoor treatment under his own supervision.

Smti Leechu has agreed to get herself admitted in the T.B. ward, provided her children are allowed to stay with her or her husband is employed in Port Blair, preferably in m.v. Milale.

Administering Anti-T.B. Drugs regularly under supervision is imperative for her complete cure. Children cannot be allowed to be in the T.B. ward for obvious reasons. May I, therefore, request you to explore the possibility of providing him a job in Port Blair, where he can look after his children as well as Smti Leechu in the hospital.

An early action in this regard is very much solicited.
