It is seen from the notes at para 13-20 on page 27A, the No. 22/51-TW/1, that the appointment of Mr. R. Ram, a Nicobar and Gineah Island, Shompen youth as Trekking Assistant at Great Nicobar, has been approved by the Lt. Governor subject to ratification by the Executive Council in its next meeting.

Subsequently the appointment of Shri V. Sebastian was taken up and recommended by the Director(TW) considering the necessity felt by the Assistant Commissioner, C.A.S., for a Trekking Assistant in addition to the existing two (para 21-22 page 28-29). This proposal was not agreed to by the Lt. Governor who felt that two Trekkers would be sufficient to help the present team of a Doctor and a Social Worker/Para later one of these two persons who were appointed as Trekking Assistant i.e. the Shompen youth left the job leaving a vacancy of Trekking Assistant at Campbell Bay.

Again the application of Shri Sebastian for appointment as Trekking Assistant was examined vide para 34-46A of linked file No. 22/51-TW/1 and finally it was decided to transfer Shri V. Sebastian, Gardner-cum-Master at Bungong Creek to Campbell Bay. In response to the letter dated 2nd March, 1977 regarding the appointment of Shri Sebastian we have informed the Member of Parliament that there was no vacancy of Trekking Assistant and the case of Shri Sebastian would be considered at the appropriate time.

Later in the month of August, 1977 the services of Shri V. Sebastian were terminated vide order No. 210 dated 1st August, 1977. The post of one Trekking Assistant is lying vacant.
