**Subj:-** Appointment of Special Messenger-regarding.

Sir,

This office received number of messages from your office as well from Pradesh Council, Medical Department and Administration for immediate delivery at Dugong creek. Most of the message receives are of urgent matter and are to be delivered within one day. It is a known fact that Dugong Creek is not acceptable with road and 2 creeks are to cross which is not possible until some arrangement is made and one messenger is ready available for carrying the message.

Tehsil Office Little Andaman is provided with only one Class IV employee and he is already overloaded with his field work and office attending work hence his service cannot be channelised frequently to carry the dugong creek message. Previously when A.P.W.D was executing its works at Dugong Creek this office had no problem in sending the message but now their work is finished and it became difficult in sending the messages.

It is, therefore, proposed that if one messenger is appointed and posted at Hut Bay his service can very well be utilised in liaisoning the South Bay and Dugong Creek ongo settlements and at the time of urgent message he can be sent.

The said proposal may please be looked into and permission for appointing one messenger on Daily rated basis be approved. In the absence of the messenger this office will not take any responsibility in delayed delivery of the urgent nature of the messages.
