The Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 is a comprehensive piece of legislation providing the detailed procedure for diversion of forest land as well as to deal with the violation of any provision contained therein. It is incorrect to say that such diversions were made at the whims and fancies of ministers and bureaucrats. It is also incorrect to say that such diversions have been made with the objective of exploiting the ferest wealth. Proposals or diversion of forest land are made after considering all pros and cons and examining all alternatives.
