to Hon'ble High Court .The various issues like Andaman Trunk Road, Health care, and food for the Jarawas etc would be covered by the Expert Committee. On the basis of the recommendations of the Expert Committee, the Government of India and A&N Administration would be formulated a policy for the well being of the Jarawas. Thereafter various measures would be taken up by the Administration as per universally accepted policy directions for the well being of the Jarawas. As such all the issues raised in para 39 and 40 would be taken care in due course.

Para 43 to 45 &48: In the light of comments in respect of para 39 and 40 nothing else is added.
