

and agreements entered into by the Officers of the Forest Department on behalf of the President with contractors, timber merchants and others and provide necessary facilities for work as per such contracts and agreements.

3. The lessee shall have no authority of transferring any demised land to any Government department or Public Undertaking or to any Private individual or Institution without the prior permission of the Andaman Forest Department. All such request for transfer of demised land will be referred to the Government in the Forest Department for their decision, which shall be binding on the lessee.

4. Forest operations by the lessee in the leased areas will be governed on the basis of 75 year conversion period. The area taken up for plantation of Cash crops and plantation crops shall also be worked by the lessee on the basis of the Project report approved by the Government. It is mandatory on the part of the lessee to restock at their own cost and expense the entire harvested area immediately or in the succeeding year with commercially valuable indigenous plant
