Andaman & Nicobar Islands, a Union Territory of India is situated in the Bay of Bengal about 1200 KM away from the main Indian land mass. The gross geographical area of there islands is 3,233 Sq.km. out of which the forest area is 7,464 Sq.km. (about 905). According to estimates based on sameling about 1.30 lakh m3 of timber 1 lakh m3 at present. The project envisages annual harvesting of above quantity of timber from little Andaman and Micobar North where infrastructural facilities have developed adequaty of timber from little Andamum and North Andamens where infrastructural facilities have to start operation in Little Andaman by taking over equipment and buildings of the Forest Depastment who have already established a Division in a small scale. During the third year the areas in North Andaman Islands will be taken up for harvest.
