

84 On analysis of the above letter from the revenue department, the following points had been observed:-

- (85) 1) Officials from Deputy Commissioner (A) had undertaken a survey in the year 2001-02, wherein AAJVS has extended service of its employees. Now since Jarawa reserved area has been extended from the previous survey, the new survey has to be done based on the Notification of 15<sup>th</sup> September 2004.
- 2) It was decided during the meeting held in the Chamber of Secretary (TW) that the Survey work will be started from 9<sup>th</sup> May 2006 by revenue department with assistance from Forest and AAJVS. But the Revenue department is requesting for engagement of Forest Department Officials. Their request is genuine since it is not their duty for demarcation in Jarawa reserve areas as it is Forest Land.
- 3) 2000 concrete pillars are available for use.

(86) Since, Officials like Patwari, Surveyor, Chainman etc of Revenue department has the expertise in land demarcation, it is proposed that we may send a requisition under the signature of Secretary (TW) to start the work as the same is delay enormously.
