

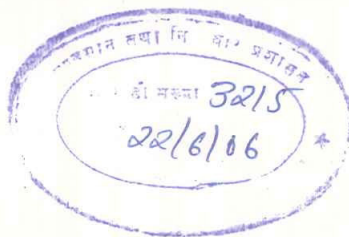

Sub: - Demarcation of Jarawa Reserved Area, reg: -

Sir,

This is with reference to the meeting held in the chamber of Secretary (TW) on 12/05/2006 regarding demarcation of Jarawa Reserve Area. In this connection this department has already sent a letter to DCF (HQ) vide no Sectt/181/2501/2521 dated 19/05/2006 asking them to resurvey the Jarawa Reserve with the help of GPS since the Jarawa area notified in terms of Geo-reference i.e. Latitude and longitude, hence the boundary cannot be fixed through the cadastral survey.

In this connection it is to submit that the Jarawa reserve passes through RF/PF/Forest area the resurvey can be done by them. Further the task of Jarawa reserve has already been surveyed by the District Administration during 2001-2002 and survey stones have been planted.

Therefore, the Forest Department may be asked to conduct the survey. The survey stones required can be collected from this office at an usual payment @ Rs 150/-. In case of any doubt/ dispute the services of the departmental surveyors shall be made available to your department.
