Minutes of meeting held in the Chamber of Special Secretary (TW) on  
5/5/2006 to discuss about demarcation of Jarawa reserve areas

A list of Officers attending the above meeting is enclosed.

After detailed deliberations on various related issues on demarcation of Jarawa reserve areas it was decided that:-

- a) The demarcation work based on the notification dated 15<sup>th</sup> September 2004 will be started from Tuesday the 9<sup>th</sup> May 2006 onwards.
- b) This work will be done by District Administration (A).
- c) The Forest department will provide necessary assistance in the form of Labour force and vehicle etc.
- d) D.C Office will use concrete poles required for the demarcation, if available, In case pillars are not available, the work may start by using wooden pillars provided by Forest Department. The wooden pillars will soon be replaced by concrete pillars to be provided by the District Office.
- e) The concrete pole engraved as "J/R" in English and in Hindi "जी/आर" with painting. (J/R stands for Jarawa reserve) (जी/आर - जारवा आरक्षित)
- f) Cost of the pole will be borne by AAJVS on receipt of the bills duly verified from the Office of Deputy Commissioner (A).
- g) Police Department will deploy Police Personnel with the above team
- h) Revenue and Forest department will issue orders for deployment of Officials from their respective departments with a copy endorsed to AAJVS and Police.
- i) DCF (HQ) with their respective Divisional Forest Officer will coordinate the whole demarcation work in Jarawa reserve areas in South and Middle Andaman.
