11. The Research Investigator has reported that the staffs of AAJVS whenever come to Hut Bay do not have facility of accommodation and storage of ration articles if for reasons could not be loaded on dinghy for Dugong Creek. It is decided that the AAJVS staffs under such condition may use the Onge Guest House at Hut bay for the purpose when no Onges will be there.
 12. Safe drinking water has to be supplied to Onges. The APWD may ensure proper maintenance of old and new wells for safe drinking water.
 13. Appointment of Doctor (Homeo) be put up for approval. Atleast one Doctor (homeo) at present will be recruited who will cover all PTGs areas from time to time.
 14. Door at Onge guest house at Hut Bay be repaired by a private carpenter immediately.
 15. Husking of coconuts should be done by engaging Onges at Dugong Creek on payment. The payment to be made by ANCOFED. The ANCOFED shall collect at Dugong Creek accordingly on usual terms and conditions.

Kadamtala

16. Report received from the Tribal Welfare Officer, Kadamtala that the poaching activities are going on in the Jarawa Reserve. In their joint patrolling during August - September 2006 they apprehended 20 poachers and registered 8 cases under PAT regulation 1956 and the SC & ST Act. Effective patrolling shall be conducted. It is also directed that the Anti poaching patrolling shall be conducted by the Task Force constituted for it under the Police and they shall make all arrangement.
17. The AAJVS staffs should be provided folding Cots for their use while on duty in the PHCs both at Kadamtala and Tusnabad and as well as Onge Guest House Hut Bay. The same may also be provided at Luis-inlet Bay.
18. In view of lack of DRM in the Jarawa areas it is also decided to appoint one DRM at Middle Strait. The DRM should be local resident of Baratang so that he may stay at Middle Strait after passing out of all convoys from both the ends viz. Jirkatang No II and Middle Strait.
