19. The Social Worker Tirur has reported that when the Jarawas do come to PHC Tusnabad after the meal time they are not provided the food. The Jarawas should henceforth be provided boiled fish and egg whenever they are brought to PHCs. They should not be served bread.
  20. Regarding providing of cloth to the Jarawas whenever they are in PHC it is decided that minimum cotton clothes be given only on demand.
  21. Only serious Jarawa patient should be brought to PHC at Kadamtala and Tirur areas. No food should be provided by AAJVS. The In-situ treatment in their habitat may be provided to the extent possible and use of traditional medicines among the Jarawa may be encouraged. The DD (TH) shall be requested to undertake frequent visit especially in Jarawa area accordingly.
  22. Iron materials to Jarawas on demand may be issued.
  23. Monthly staff meeting in the chamber of Secretary (TW) shall be called in first Wednesday of each month.
